Religion 8

Eighth-grade religion focuses on a series of religious truths that students are likely to find challenged during their high school years. Students learn the truths, how we know they're true, and common errors people make in relation to the truths. Examples include the existence of God, the goodness of God, the primacy of love, and the reality of free will.

In addition to studying their faith, students practice it through prayer and Lectio Divina.
